

Knowing God Loves Me ¹

- 1 John 4:10* This is love [*agape*]: not that we loved [*agape*] God, but that he loved [*agape*] us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.
- Psalms 18:16* He reached down from on high and took hold of me; he drew me out of deep waters.
- Jeremiah 31:3* The LORD appeared to us in the past, saying: "I have loved [*ahav*] you with an everlasting love [*ahav*]; I have drawn you with loving-kindness [*chesed*]."
- Isaiah 49:16* See, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands; your walls are ever before me.
- Hebrews 13:5b* Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.
- Isaiah 54:10* Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love [*chesed*] for you will not be shaken nor my covenant of peace be removed," says the LORD, who has compassion on you.
- Psalms 103:11* For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love [*chesed*] for those who fear [*revere*] him;
- Isaiah 43:2-5* When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. For I am the LORD, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior; I give Egypt for your ransom, Cush and Seba in your stead. Since you are precious and honored in my sight, and because I love [*ahav*] you, I will give men in exchange for you, and people in exchange for your life. Do not be afraid, for I am with you; I will bring your children from the east and gather you from the west.
- Romans 5:8* But God demonstrates his own love [*agape*] for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- John 3:16* For God so loved [*agape*] the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
- 1 John 3:16* This is how we know what love [*agape*] is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.
- John 15:13* Greater love [*agape*] has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends.
- 1 John 3:1a* How great is the love [*agape*] the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!
- John 13:1b* Having loved [*agape*] his own who were in the world, he now showed them the full extent of his love [*agape*].
- John 15:9* As the Father has loved [*agape*] me, so have I loved [*agape*] you. Now remain in my love [*agape*].
- Romans 8:35, 38-39* Who shall separate us from the love [*agape*] of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword?
For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love [*agape*] of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
